

Class 5 and 6 - Summer Holiday Homework

Our Geography topic next term will be 'Mountains and Rivers'. Please choose at least one of the tasks below to complete as your homework over the summer holidays. We look forward to seeing what you create!

- Create five maths word problems based on a river or mountain theme - include the answers on a separate sheet!
- Create a water log to record how much water you and your family use in a week.
- Write a poem of at least 8 lines on the theme of rivers or mountains.
- Go for a walk along a river (with an adult!) and take five photographs / draw five sketches of interesting features or animals. Present these to the class.
- Research and design four top trumps cards for animals in British rivers.
- Write an article for a children's geography magazine about a river or mountain of your choice. Include sub-headings, fact boxes and illustrations.
- Create a river or mountain collage using any materials, and label all the parts.
- Research famous water paintings and choose one to recreate as your own artwork. Present your research and your art to the class.
- Write a story which involves a river or mountain.
- Make a presentation to explain the water cycle. Use scientific vocabulary.
- Find out all about pollution to our rivers. Present this information to the class in any way you choose.
- Research farming on the River Nile. Present your findings to the class in a creative manner.
- Create your own 4-page booklet all about rivers. You could include facts, wildlife, the water cycle, river sports... It's up to you!
- Make a model of a river from source to mouth, using any materials you wish. Learn five river facts related to your model to present to the class.
- Write a detailed account of at least 2 activities that people take part in, on Mountains. You may want to include safety aspects and famous people that take part.
