It also applies to gatherings in churchyards (other than graveside services) or car parks.

Christmas ...?? and other special days in the life of the church in these next months

According to at least one of the dailies recently, Christmas is cancelled. Well of course, it isn't! Whatever happens, we will prepare for and celebrate the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ – but quite how, remains very uncertain, for all of us. At this point, it is difficult to imagine what the future holds. The Prime Minister is still hopeful, and Archbishop Justin has written an article this week outlining his concerns about the impact of current measures on Christmas and the most vulnerable. But we need to be realistic and accept the strong likelihood that we cannot expect the usually full diary of special services and events. Carol Services are almost certainly not going to happen, for instance. So, we are planning for a much simpler Advent and Christmas IN church. But we also want to make the most of the new ways that we've discovered in 2020 to share reflections and worship. So, alongside a trimmed down church-Christmas diary, we'll be offering more films online to enable people to reflect and worship at home. Christmas Communion will take place in all our open churches. When it comes to our All Souls commemoration, that will be online. On Remembrance Sunday there will be an Act of Remembrance at each Sunday service – in some places these will need to be simpler than usual, and the laying of wreaths will need to comply with all the social distancing regulations in place at the time. We'll continue to avoid our customary 5th Sunday United Services to reduce the risk of transmission. And of course, if things change and we're permitted to do more than we anticipate, we will rejoice and be able to make some additions to our plans.
